The Building Is Ours!

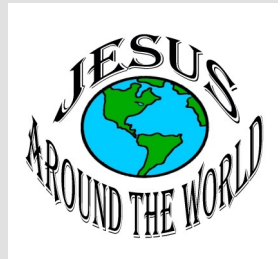
All paperwork was signed by the middle of May; the church building and grounds now officially belong to St. Andrew's Anglican Church.
